Rules

- Photographs and art must be original works of the entrant.
- Contests open to any youth ages 8-18. *Jr. Division* 8-12, *Sr. Division* 13-18.
- Youth ages 5-7 may exhibit and receive participation ribbon only.
- Each participant can enter up to three (3) photographs and three (3) art exhibits.
- All entries in the photography show must be 4" x 6" mats optional no frames.
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place premiums will be given in each category with an overall *Best of Show* winning a rosette in Art and Photography.

Photography Categories (color or black and white accepted):

- 1. <u>Nature</u> Any subject found in nature, plants or flowers, etc.
- 2. Scenic Landscapes, seascapes, architectural design.
- 3. 4-H or FFA in Action Any photo of a 4-H or FFA activity.
- 4. <u>People</u> Any photograph featuring people as the main subject.
- 5. Animals Any photograph featuring animals as the main subject.

Art Categories:

- 1. Drawing Pencil, pen and ink, colored pencil, charcoal.
- 2. <u>Painting</u> Oil, acrylic, watercolor.
- 3. Other sculptures and all other entries.



All work must have the following information on the back: name, age, phone, category, division and title. Entries showing name or other identifying information on front will not be eligible for judging.

Each work will be judged only in the category for which it is submitted. If no category is designated, the exhibit committee will choose one.
