



To: All 2019 4-H Charters

You should have begun work on your 4-H Charting Book and have determined your plans for completing the 4-H Charting program. If you plan be part of the 2019 Charting Class at Tri-County Older 4-H Camp the week of June 10-14, you need to complete your portfolio by **May 31st**.

Remember this can be a two or three year program; however you are encouraged to complete your Chart this year. Being a part of the Charting Class at Older Camp is the preferred option; however not everyone attends 4-H Camp, so you can complete your Charting by meeting with the 4-H Agent.

Check-List Suggestions:

Begin by reviewing page 3 Checklist for Charters and email with questions or concerns anytime...don't wait.....stay in touch! By now you should have completed the following:

- ✓ Filled in information on page 5 stopping at "Charting Book Due Date" which is **May 31st**.
- ✓ Selected your adult reviewer and sent the letter. (Place copy in book)
- ✓ Reviewed page 10 and have an understanding what a portfolio is and how you should complete the activities for each section.
- ✓ Reviewed Charter's code of ethics (page 11) with adult reviewer and both signed. (Place copy in book.)
- ✓ Completed Self-Understanding pages 13-26.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask! The point of this is to allow yourself to grow!

Upcoming timeline suggestions are:

- ✓ Complete Critical Thinking and Decision-Making pages 27-32 by **April 5th**.
- ✓ Complete Communication section, pages 33-36 by **April 10th**.
- ✓ Complete Leadership section, pages 37-39 by **April 15th**.
- ✓ Complete Where Am I Going section, pages 41-52 by **April 20th**.
- ✓ Final review of Charting Portfolio due date to Extension Office by **May 31st**.

Charting Books are reviewed and a comment sheet is provided. A Charting Class list will be prepared for Older Camp, week of June 10-14 with Charting Books and list given to Charting Instructor Sunday.
