Club Member Expectations

- Members are expected to be in attendance at scheduled 4-H meetings and events. If members cannot be present, he/she is expected to notify the leader and let them know the reason of the absence. School activities, religious activities, college classes, work and sickness are excused absences.
- 4-H Members must <u>enroll</u> with their 4-H club in <u>September and October</u>. Members are responsible for submitting their enrollment card and health statement to the 4-H leader. If the member misses the September or October meeting it is their responsibility to contact the 4-H leader for the enrollment information.
- Members are expected to actively participate in meetings (do a demonstration, participate in service, bring refreshments, etc.) Members will receive a Program Planning Sheet that will alert them to these expectations.
- Members are expected to complete a project book, and actively record and an exhibit.
- Parents are welcomed and encouraged to participate in club meetings and functions. Siblings who are not old enough to participate in 4-H are asked to stay with their parents at all times.
- All rules and regulations of the State of West Virginia are in effect during the 4-H function. Members and parents are also asked to respect the rules and regulations of the facility being used. Appropriate actions will be taken for those not abiding by these regulations.
- Each member is required to purchase club member insurance for \$1.00 (\$2 if Horse).
- Respect is expected from each member. We can have fun but we need to respect each other. Remember, those planning activities for this 4-H club are volunteers. Please treat each member and volunteer with respect and courtesy at all times.
- Please be courteous to others and be on time to begin and end the meetings.
